What is NAMI Ending the Silence?

NAMI Ending the Silence (ETS) is a prevention and early intervention program that engages youth, school staff and families in a discussion about mental health. Audience members learn to recognize the early warning signs of mental health conditions and learn what to do if they or someone they know is showing these signs. The chance to hear directly from a young adult with a mental health condition dispels myths, instills a message of hope and recovery and encourages individuals to reduce stigma. Audience members can ask questions of family members and individuals experiencing mental health conditions. By engaging youth, school staff and families in a discussion about mental health conditions, young people dealing with mental health issues realize they're not alone.
